A Letter from the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

The Diocese of Camden has grown tremendously over the course of its 80 years in service to the people of South Jersey. As a diocese, we are continuing to adjust to the constant changes affecting the Catholic Church throughout the Northeastern United States, and we are working to create more dynamic parish communities.



Bishop Sullivan has actively engaged the lay faithful and clergy in promoting the wellbeing of our parishes and the diocese. By frequently visiting parishes, schools, and other institutions, he has made clear his vision of supporting his priests, increasing priestly vocations, encouraging youth and young adult formation, and providing a quality religious education, especially through our Catholic Schools.

Now, midway through the second decade of the 21st century, it is time for this generation of Catholics to make their mark on the history of the diocese. **Catholic Strong**, the Campaign for the Catholic Community of South Jersey will primarily benefit our local parishes. Seventy percent of the funds raised through this effort will be allocated for parish needs as determined locally and 30 percent will fund the diocese's coordination and support of various ministries.

This effort should not be mistaken for the House of Charity, which is expended to maintain the important outreach ministries and programs of the Diocese. The mission of this campaign is to provide funds to ensure that our parishes are financially stable and allow the Diocese the opportunity to address long-term and extraordinary needs so that our Church will have the strength and stability to serve future generations of Catholics.

The **Catholic Strong** Campaign will call upon all parishioners throughout our six counties to take an active and supportive role. It is my sincere hope that each of you will take part in this process by responding to this critical initiative. Your participation is vital to the future of Saint Simon Stock Parish.

READINGS FOR THIS SUNDAY FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



First Reading: Deuteronomy 18:15-20

Moses explains to the people that a prophet will come from among them, and that they should listen to this prophet's words, for God has told him of this prophet. God also tells Moses that anyone who pretends to speak in his words, or speaks in the name of other gods shall die.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 7:32-35

Paul tells the Corinthians how an unmarried man or woman is able to devote themselves fully to God without concern for the needs of a spouse. Paul explains that God wants to help them promote good and devote themselves more fully to God.

Gospel: Mark 1:21-28

As Jesus was teaching, a man with an unclean spirit came to the synagogue and asked if Jesus had come to destroy them. Jesus ordered the spirit out of the man, who shrieked violently as the spirit departed. The people were amazed at the authority he had over the spirit.

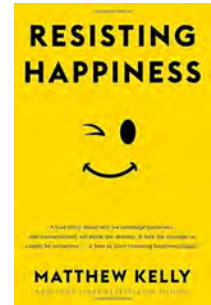
