How the *Catholic Strong* Campaign differs from House of Charity

The ***Catholic Strong*** Campaign is different from the House of Charity, which funds the day-to-day programs, services, and ministries of the Diocese and helps parishes, families, and individuals with immediate needs across South Jersey. Primarily, the ***Catholic Strong*** Campaign will generate funds for the parishes themselves. However, 30% of the overall funds raised through ***Catholic Strong*** will be directed at diocesan needs that are not currently funded through House of Charity income, including expanding evangelization and social service outreach efforts, as well as allowing the Diocese to focus on key areas of the 2015 Bishop’s Commission on Catholic Schools report. At its core, ***Catholic Strong*** is a campaign to expand, strengthen and empower our Church to stand prepared to serve future generations.

As we begin the ***Catholic Strong*** Campaign here at Saint Simon Stock Parish, the House of Charity will continue, and in fact run concurrently. We are confident that these two important efforts will co-exist successfully.

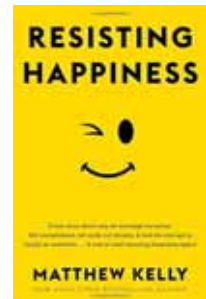
2018 *LENTEN CHATTERBOX*

READINGS FOR THIS SUNDAY SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT



First Reading: Genesis 22:1-2, 9a, 10-13, 15-18

God ordered Abraham to take his beloved only son to Moriah and offer him as a sacrifice. Abraham built an altar and took out a knife to sacrifice his son Isaac. But God called out to him and told him of blessings that would be bestowed on him and his descendants because he had been willing to do what God had asked.

Second Reading: Romans 8:31b-34

Paul reminds the people that God did not spare his only Son, but gave him up for the sake of all people. This proves God views us all as his children, and that no person can harm or condemn us because God will protect us.

Gospel: Mark 9:2-10

Jesus led Peter, James and John up a high mountain, where he conversed with Elijah and Moses. A voice proclaimed 'This is my Son, my beloved. Listen to him.' Then Jesus was alone and warned them not to tell anyone what they had seen until he had risen from the dead.
