



### First Reading: Acts 3:13-15, 17-19

Peter reminds the people that they allowed Jesus to be killed, and preferred to allow a murderer to be released. But God raised him from the dead as had been prophesied. Therefore, all people should believe and turn to God, that their sins might be forgiven.

### Second Reading: I John 2:1-5a



# St Simon Stock Health Tips

Polypharmacy is the concurrent use of multiple medications by a patient. It is most common in the elderly and can sometimes be more harmful than helpful by creating more risk than benefit. Health professionals consider polypharmacy a situation that requires monitoring and review to validate whether all medications are still necessary.

Specific concerns about polypharmacy include increased risk for adverse drug reactions, drug interactions and cost. Sometimes it can be associated with decreased quality of life including decreased mobility and cognition.

If you are concerned about too many medications talk to your doctor. Never stop your medication on your own. Sometimes a larger number of medications is necessary to manage a patients condition. However a periodic and thoughtful review of medication by a physician with his patient is reasonable and can be helpful.
