

# PASTORAL ANNOUNCEMENTS

To all of the good people and friends of Saint Simon Stock Parish,

As you may have heard, a major campaign is underway at Saint Simon Stock Parish: **Catholic Strong**, the Campaign for the Catholic Community of South Jersey, is seeking to secure a minimum of \$50 million, which will primarily benefit our local parishes. Seventy percent of the funds raised through this effort (a total of \$35 million) will be allocated for parish needs and thirty percent (a total of \$15 million) will fund the diocese's coordination and support of various ministries. The mission of this campaign is to ensure that our parishes are financially stable and allow the opportunity to address long-term and extraordinary needs so that our Church will have the strength and stability to serve future generations of Catholics.

### Know Jesus

in the breaking

#### First Reading: Acts 3:13-15, 17-19

Peter reminds the people that they allowed Jesus to be killed, and preferred to allow a murderer to be released. But God raised him from the dead as had been prophesied. Therefore, all people should believe and turn to God, that their sins might be forgiven.

#### Second Reading: I John 2:1-5a

Jesus was offered up for the sins of the world. The only way to prove true faith in him, is to honor his commandments. Anyone who claims to believe, yet does not keep his word, does not truly believe.

#### Gospel: Luke 24:35-48

Jesus appeared to two disciples, though at first they feared he was a ghost. Jesus ate with them to prove he was not a ghost. He explained that he had fulfilled the prophets words about him. He also explained that in his name they must preach doing penance for the forgiveness of sins.

## St Simon Stock Health Tips

Polypharmacy is the concurrent use of multiple medications by a patient. It is most common in the elderly and can sometimes be more harmful than helpful by creating more risk than benefit. Health professionals consider polypharmacy a situation that requires monitoring and review to validate whether all medications are still necessary.

Specific concerns about polypharmacy include increased risk for adverse drug reactions, drug interactions and cost. Sometimes it can be associated with decreased quality of life including decreased mobility and cognition.

If you are concerned about too many medications talk to your doctor. Never stop your medication on your own. Sometimes a larger number of medications is necessary to manage a patient's condition. However a periodic and thoughtful review of medication by a physician with his patient is reasonable and can be helpful.
