### First Reading: Acts 2:42-47

In the early days of the Church in Jerusalem, the faithful listened intently to the teachings of the apostles. They lived a communal life, sharing all property in common and praying and taking their meals together.

### Second Reading: 1 Peter 1:3-9

In this first letter from Peter, he speaks to the Christians with great joy and confidence, reminding them that through Christ's resurrection, they have been given a new birth and are heirs to the kingdom of heaven.

### Gospel: John 20:19-31

After his resurrection, Jesus appears to his disciples and gives them the power to forgive sins. Thomas, who is absent, sees Christ later and believes in His resurrection after feeling His wounds. Christ admonishes Thomas by saying, "You became a believer because you saw Me. Blessed are they who have not seen and believed."

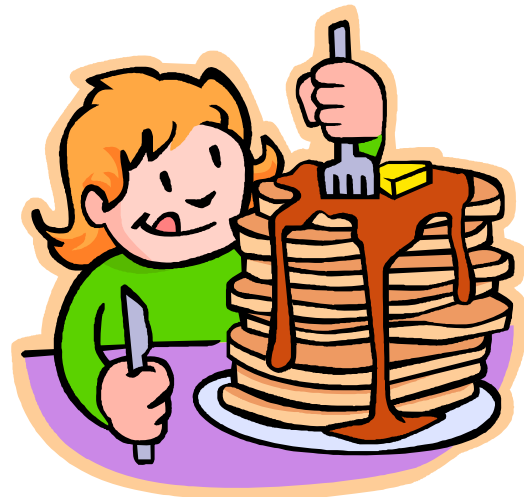



Dear sisters and brothers,

I write to thank you for your enthusiastic participation in this year's annual *faithFULL* Food Drive. Parishes and schools throughout the diocese collected over 77,000 pounds of food, which will feed thousands of our neighbors here in South Jersey.

Hunger is an urgent issue in many communities in our diocese: one in six people in the region are food insecure, including one in four children. Our Gospel mandate to take action is clear: Jesus reminds us that whenever we feed someone who is hungry, we feed Christ himself.

The *faithFULL* Food Drive was a tremendous response to the needs of our brothers and sisters thanks to the effective work and cooperation of many people and groups, Parish ministries, including the Society of St. Vincent de Paul, parish youth groups, and the Knights of Columbus, who together collaborated to involve entire church communities. Catholic schools participated creatively; two high schools charged canned goods for admission to basketball games, for example. Social service organizations in the diocese helped to make sure the donated food would be distributed efficiently to those in need. Thank you to Catholic Charities, the Food Bank of South Jersey in Pennsauken, the Community FoodBank of New Jersey in Egg Harbor Township, and a number of parish-based food pantries; and our priests for their leadership on this project.

As the need for food persists, the diocese will sponsor a second annual *faithFULL* Food Drive next year. Please save the date: Sunday, March 1, 2015.

May the Lord bless your generosity and concern for the least among us.
