### HOUSE OF CHARITY UPDATE

Our goal for this year's House of Charity is \$87, 324.37. Last year we collected a very generous amount from our parishioners, \$84, 523. To date we have received donations totaling **\$ 78,010 (89% of goal)**. Thank you to all who have contributed.

**As an incentive, if we go over our goal, 87,324.37, we will get 25% of all monies collected between the money collected last year, \$84,523 and our goal. AND, if we exceed our goal, then we also will receive an additional 25% of all monies collected over our goal.**

Right now we are approximately \$10,000 short of making our goal. If you have not contributed yet, there is still time to do so. You can make an outright contribution, or you can make a pledge and pay it with as many as 10 payments. The House of Charity will bill you. You can also make a credit card payment or a debit payment.

Pledge cards are in the back of the Church. Please consider donating to the House of Charity/Bishop's Annual Appeal. Your donation will not only help the House of Charity make their goal, but will also help your parish make our goal.
