### First Reading: Exodus 22:20-26

This passage from the book of Exodus enjoins all to adhere to specific religious and social laws. It urges all to act with justice and compassion towards others.

### Second Reading: 1 Thessalonians 1:5c-10

Paul praises the Thessalonians for receiving the word of God so eagerly and totally. Word of their faithfulness has spread throughout Macedonia and Greece; they have become a model for all Christians.

### Gospel: Matthew 22:34-40

Matthew recounts the incident in which a lawyer, seeking to entrap Jesus, asks, "Teacher, which commandment of the law is the greatest?" With simplicity and authority, Jesus responds that the first commandment is to love God with one's entire being; the second is to love one's neighbor as oneself.

## PARISH 5<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY

On **November 2**, St. Simon Stock will celebrate our 5<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. Bishop Sullivan will be the principal celebrant at the 9:30 am Mass. Following the Mass, the Prayer Garden will be dedicated to Catherine McAuley, RSM, Foundress of the Sisters of Mercy. Sister Agnes and Sister Immaculata will be here to join in these festivities. From 1956-2009, the Sisters of Mercy from Trim Ireland and the Meath Diocese served our parish and our school. This is a very special celebration of their dedication to us. A reception will follow in the Father John F. Bourke Memorial Hall following the ceremonies.

## SPECIAL EBOLA COLLECTION

At the request of Bishop Dennis Sullivan, our parish will take up a collection this weekend to assist the Hospitaller Order of St. John of God who has been treating Ebola victims in Liberia and Sierra Leone. Several brothers and co-workers have died treating these patients. According to one of the Brothers, "They need all the support we can give them to complete the isolation area and to supply specific hospital materials – gloves, masks, goggles, etc – as well as disinfectants to control and treat the Ebola virus... There is no vaccine and no specific effective treatment for this disease, and treatments can only deal with the symptoms, which makes it a matter of life and death to introduce preventive measures and prevent contagion spreading to family members and the health care personnel treating the sick," he said. Bishop Sullivan requests that we offer our prayers as well for those suffering from Ebola and for those who are caring for them.

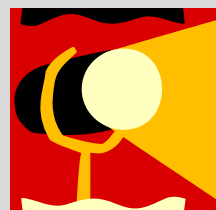
