READINGS FOR THIS SUNDAY SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT



First Reading: Isaiah 40:1-5, 9-11

Isaiah emphasizes that from the desert to the mountains, all people must prepare for "the glory of the Lord to be revealed." Rather than looking only at God's power, Isaiah focuses on God's kindness, comparing it to a shepherd who feeds and cares for his flock.

Second Reading: 2 Peter 3:8-14

For those who are impatient for the Second Coming, Peter explains that time is different to God than to people. He reminds them that they should be grateful for the extra time to prepare, and concentrate on striving to become all that God would want them to be.

Gospel: Mark 1:1-8

In this passage, John the Baptist stressed the importance of the coming of the Messiah. He acknowledged that he was only the messenger, and unfit to "stoop and untie his sandal straps." John urged them to prepare for one far holier than he, who would walk among them.

CHRISTMAS GIVING TREE



Archangel Council #7429, Knights of Columbus and the St. Vincent de Paul Society (SVDP) in conjunction with the Parish Community of St. Simon Stock, are, once again, sponsoring a Christmas Giving Tree. We do this in an attempt to insure as many in our community as possible may be able to share in the blessings of the Christmas Season.

We have sent letters to all the schools in our area asking them to distribute white index cards to families in need. Each child has been asked to request a present.

We ask them to limit the cost of the present to around \$40. You will see the first name and the sex of the child along with a control number. The St. Vincent de Paul Society is doing the same with their clients. We hope to give a gift to every child in the family from infant to the end of elementary school.

This year we are also adopting Veteran's Haven. Veteran's Haven deals with veterans who are in real need of help.

On the weekend of Nov. 22/23 cards will be placed on the bulletin boards at the entrances to the church. Most of the white cards will have the first name and sex of a child along with a specific request. Some will have the name and sex of a child without a specific request. . For Veteran's Haven, we request gift cards from various stores. In this manner the veterans can buy what they need. We will post some yellow index cards representing senior citizens.

Please come to the bulletin boards, select a card for the person for whom you wish to obtain a gift and attach the index card to the outside of the wrapped gift and return it on the weekend of Dec. 13/14. We need to collect the gifts by this date in order to insure proper delivery. Each family will also receive a food basket.
