



## CHRISTMAS GIVING TREE

Archangel Council #7429, Knights of Columbus and the St. Vincent de Paul Society (SVDP) in conjunction with the Parish Community of St. Simon Stock, are, once again, sponsoring a Christmas Giving Tree. We do this in an attempt to insure as many in our community as possible may be able to share in the blessings of the Christmas Season.

We have sent letters to all the schools in our area asking them to distribute white index cards to families in need. Each child has been asked to request a present.

**We ask them to limit the cost of the present to around \$40. You will see the first name and the sex of the child along with a control number. The St. Vincent de Paul Society is doing the same with their clients. We hope to give a gift to every child in the family from infant to the end of elementary school.**

**This year we are also adopting Veteran's Haven. Veteran's Haven deals with veterans who are in real need of help.**

***On the weekends of Nov. 18th/19th & 25th/26th cards will be placed on tables at the entrances to the church. Most of the white cards will have the first name and sex of a child along with a specific request. Some will have the name and sex of a child without a specific request. For Veteran's Haven, we request gift cards from various stores. In this manner the veterans can buy what they need. We will post some yellow index cards representing senior citizens.***

***Please come to the tables, select a card for the person for whom you wish to obtain a gift and attach the index card to the outside of the wrapped gift and return it on the weekend of Dec. 9th/10th. We need to collect the gifts by this date in order to insure proper delivery. Each family will also receive a food basket.***

If you would like to make a monetary contribution, we can turn it into a gift. Please make checks payable to "Archangel Council #7429". And place it into an envelope marked "Giving Tree" and drop it into the collection basket. We thank you in advance for your generosity.

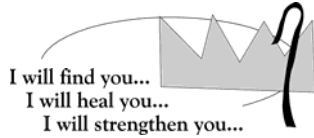

## READINGS FOR THIS SUNDAY

OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST,  
KING OF THE UNIVERSE



### First Reading: Ezekiel 34:11-12, 15-17

This passage beautifully describes how the Lord God, as shepherd, will tend his flock. He will rescue those who are lost, bring back those who stray, heal the sick, and "pasture" all.

### Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 15:20-26, 28

Paul once again stresses the significance of Christ's resurrection in the total divine plan, emphasizing that Christ's rising means that those who believe in him will also rise after death. Christianity, he argues, is meaningless if it concerns only this life on earth. In the end, even death will be destroyed, and "God will be all in all."

### Gospel: Matthew 25:31-46

With words both poetic and vivid, Jesus tells the disciples that since he is present in all people, whatever they do to "one of my least brothers" they do to him; and whatever they fail to do to his "least," they fail to do to him.

## DIOCESE OF CAMDEN - *Office of Child and Youth Protection*

The Office of Child and Youth Protection is announcing CAP (Child Assault Prevention) sessions. CAP is the safe environment training program for adults who have regular contact with minors. Attendance is required in order to comply with the USCCB's *Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People*. The policy of the Diocese of Camden is that adults will attend CAP once every five years.

**CAP 1** teaches attendees to **recognize child abuse and neglect** and how to report to the proper authorities. Adults are taught that children have the right to be safe, strong and free. CAP 1 is for new volunteers and employees.

**CAP 2** is called **CAP's Bullying Prevention Program** and is a workshop addressing bullying awareness and bullying prevention. Cyber-bullying is also presented. **CAP 3** is called **Cyber-Empowerment** and is a workshop which promotes adults understanding of cyber activity of youth while teaching them realistic ways to help children keep their own rights and guard the rights of others in the cyber-sphere. Each presentation is 90 minutes. Adults who are new employees or volunteers should attend CAP 1 before attending CAP 2 or CAP 3. After five years, adults have the option of attending CAP 1, 2 or 3 when they renew their CAP. 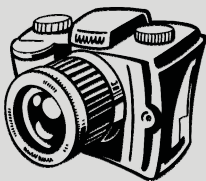
